1. We must draw near to Listen to the voice of God

- 1 Samuel 3:10- "The LORD came and stood there, calling as at the other times, "Samuel! Samuel!" Then Samuel said, "Speak, for your servant is listening."
- Psalm 46:10- "Be still and know that I am God; I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth!"

2. We must draw near to be strengthened in the Lord each day

- Matthew 11:28-29- "Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls."
- Isaiah 40:31- "but those who hope in the Lord will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary; they will walk and not be faint."
