



The Lord is our Shepherd!

This summer we met daily for prayer with our fellow-teachers and busily prepared for the new school year at Taylor Christian School. We anticipated beginning the year with distance learning and eventually returning to on-campus instruction. Surprisingly, we are doing both simultaneously but not in a way that any of us expected.



Financial hardships, the late summer spike in coronavirus cases in our area, and individual concerns with distance learning caused numerous families to make the last-minute decision to withdraw their children from our school. Ultimately, so few students remained on the roster that the TCS board made the difficult decision to not operate as a traditional school in this 2020-21 school year.

Inspired by a program hosted by the Boys and Girls Club of McAllen, we have quickly re-organized to launch a new initiative called E-Camp. At a cost of five dollars a day, children from any area school that has on-line classes may spend their school day on our campus, where we provide internet and the support of experienced teachers to assist the children in-person in their distance learning.

We believe it is a great alternative to children being on-line at home alone while their parents are at work. This window of opportunity may only be open for a month or two, but we want to offer it while we can to help as many families as possible.

Would you pray with us? We're praying...

- that God will continue to connect us with the families who need this support
- that through it, God will enable us to share His love and the Truth of His Word with each child
- that God will also work through this outreach to open our eyes to other needs around us and expand our connections in the community to join with other Christians in addressing those needs.

Our principal led us in a meaningful study of Psalm 23 during our teacher in-service days. Since then, the path of this school year has taken a very unexpected turn, but we have a deep assurance that the Lord is with us and that He is leading us along this path for His Name's sake.

We pray that you, too, are sensing the leading of the Good Shepherd in your life and can rest in Him today.


