

Our church parking lot recently was resealed, new parking marking and signage. Thank you EUMC Trustees for taking care of the church.













Our Mayo Taylor Award Winner moved to Walton, Kentucky to be closer to his son's growing family in 2012. He joined Erlanger United Methodist Church in 2014, becoming an active member of the United Methodist Men, leader of the Finance Committee, and a member of the Administrative Board and Trustee Committee. Since, he's also served as our Church Treasurer and on the Grace Edgett Board. He can also can frequently be found helping with the Children's Ministry activities.

Church has become a very important factor in his life and Erlanger United Methodist Church is the main reason. The love and friendliness of this congregation has shown him the real meaning of God's Love. He is in awe of the way this church lifts everyone in need and is always there to help one another.

He throws himself 100% into anything he becomes a part. He is a 40+ year member of the Masonic Lodge, a member of the Order of Hercules, Kentucky Colonels, Decatur Central Alumni Association, the Indiana University Alumni Association as well as his many church activities.

Our awardee, Charlie Love, was born on December 26th, 1951, in Indianapolis, Indiana. He was the third child of four of the late Ezra and Mary Love.

He graduated from Decatur Central H.S. in 1970. He then entered and graduated from Indiana University while holding a full-time job, being married, and becoming a father.

He married Gaynell Bailey in 1973 and became a father to Charles Wayne Love II in 1974. He worked throughout his life as a Finance Manager for companies such as Borg Warner Commercial Finance, Transamerica Finance, General Electric Finance, and retiring in 2013 as a Vice-President from TCIF Bank.

He lived in Indianapolis, Indiana until transferring to Evansville, Indiana in 1986. He lived in Evansville until 2012 when his wife retired. While in Evansville he involved himself in coaching his son in many youth sports. He is a lifelong follower of Indiana University Athletics and has held season tickets to IU football for almost 30 years.

The loves of his life are his family in which he plays a big part every day. Avery, age 13, Bailey, age 11, Charley, age 7 and Tripp also known as Charles Wayne Love III, age 5 are the lights of his heart. He is often found "ubering" his granddaughters to tennis, soccer, basketball, school, and various other functions. He is a "Papaw" in every sense of the word.
